Honors and Awards Committee Report

The Isotopes and Radiation Division (IRD) Honors and Awards (H&A) Subcommittee is responsible for reviewing the three IRD awards; the Radiation Science and Technology Award, the Mashima Award (joint with ANS Materials Science and Technology Division) and the Vogt Scholarship. The current H&A Subcommittee members are: Jack Brenizer, chair, R. Gregory Downing, Lin-Wen Hu, Stephen LaMont, John Metzger and Lav Tandon.

In early February 2008, the Committee reviewed six(x) and four (4) graduate applications for the Vogt Scholarship. Although the Vogt Award favors an undergraduate student, our top candidate for the Vogt award was Michael Alex Brown (one vote shy of a unanimous choice), a graduate student at Oregon State University. This time our committee did not have any candidate that received more than two votes as our second choice. Michael was accepted as the recipient of the 2008/2009 Vogt Scholarship.

In a separate action, Chairman Jack Brenizer reviewed the single nomination for the 2008 Mishima Award. In March he cast an affirmative ballot for the nominee, Dr. Robert E. Einziger, a professor at the University of Florida, on behalf of the IRD.
